


STEP 4

Insert Short Hamper Rod through the loop in the fabric closest to the plastic bottom. Insert the Long Hamper Rod through the other end of the Hamper fabric.

Attach the bottom of the Hamper to the Chassis Assembly by placing each side of the Short Hamper Rod in the slots on the Chassis Assembly. Next, place both ends of the Long Hamper Rod into the Hook Bolts located under both sides of the handle assembly.

Clip the plastic hangers on each side of the Hamper to both Bottom Handles.

Brush Height Adjustment:


Simply pull in on the Adjustment Handle and move up or down to move brushes up and down to desired height. The most effective way to sweep debris up is to have the brush tips barely touching the tops of grass blades or pavement. If the unit seems to push "too hard", move the adjustment bar one notch higher.


Dumping Hamper:

The Hamper is easily dumped by removing the Long Hamper Rod from both Hook Bolts on the Handles and removing the Short Hamper Rod from both sides of the Chassis Assembly. Pull the Hamper assembly out from the unit and dump where desired. Return the Hamper assembly to the sweeper unit to continue sweeping.



The unique feature on the SW26PRE is the ability for the Handle Assembly to be folded over creating even more space for storage. To accomplish this all you have to do in un-lock both Cross Tube Locks and fold the top of the handle assembly down to the Chassis Assembly. Next fold the Support Tube (with the caster wheels) down towards the wheels and brush assembly.





Adjustment Handle

DO NOT LUBRICATE THIS UNIT!

The sweeper bearings are pre-lubricated and sealed prior to assembly. No other lubrication is needed for this unit.

DO NOT GREASE OR OIL THE GEARS IN THE WHEELS.

If you put grease or oil on these the brush WILL NOT WORK.

If you do add a lubrication, simply wipe the wheels and pinions clean of all grease or oil.


Pinion and Pawl Installation




Assembly Components

- F. Long Hamper Rod




NOTE: All references to "Right Hand" and "Left Hand" are from position behind the sweeper.

Step I
Swing the Support Tube out until it locks into place on the stops on the inside of the Chassis Assembly.



STEP 2

Un-fold both Right Hand and Left Hand Handle Assemblies and lock them using the Cross Tube Locks. Next, insert the top of the Left Hand Handle Assembly into the top of the Right Hand Handle Assembly. The two assemblies lock into place with a spring button on the Left Hand Handle Assembly and a hole on the Right Hand Handle Assembly.



STEP 3

Attach both Handle Assembly ends to the inside of the Chassis Assembly using four (2 per side) 1/4" x 1-1/2" Hex Head Bolts and four 1/4" Hex Nuts.
